

KS2 SATS RESULTS 2015

The tables below outline the progress made between Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2, and attainment made in Key Stage 2 for 2015. This year, just 9 pupils sat the KS2 Assessments and each child represented 11.1%, which makes comparisons with other, larger schools, problematic.

A tenth child took part in the SATS but was removed during the checking exercise as he wasn't educated in England prior to the tests.

In 2014 17 pupils sat the KS2 Assessments and each child also represented 5.9%
