


English

In English we will be looking at Pugs of the Frozen North by Philip Reeve. We will be writing a character description of our own made up pugs, a prediction of what we think will happen during the race and re-writing our own version of our favourite obstacle during the race.



Geography

Our Geography topic for this term is the Rivers and Mountains. We will spend the first half term looking at mountains from around the world, the features that classify them as a mountains then research and create a poster for a mountain. In the second half term we will focus on rivers.

Maths

In maths we will be building on skills learnt previously this year. Our first topics this term are fractions and geometry and place value, addition and subtraction. We will also have a focus on mental maths, with a daily test to start each lesson. As well as additional timestables lessons mainly for year 4s.

Art

Our Art focus for this term is pointillism. We will be looking at the colour palette to create hot and cold palettes which will lead to creating our final art project linked to our Geography topic.

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Science

Science for this half term is on Wednesday afternoons. We will be looking at states of matter and carrying out experiment to change states using heat. We will then look into the water cycle and the process of condensation and evaporation.

Computing

Computing will link to our Geography work with the final aim to be producing our own poster of a mountain including facts, images and other skills we have learned throughout the series of lessons.
