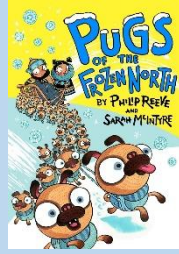


# DISCOVERERS Spring Term

## English

In English we will be looking at Ice Palace by Robert Swindells and Pugs of the Frozen North by Philip Reeve. We will be writing a newspaper article celebrating Ivan saving the children of the Pine-woods and a narrative piece about the race to the top of the world.



## Geography

Our geography topic for this term is Rivers and Mountains. We will spend the first half term focusing on geographical terms such as longitude, latitude, northern/southern hemisphere and linking them to rivers before moving onto mountains in the second half term ending in a focus on the mountain ranges in France.

## Maths

In maths we will be building on skills learnt in previous years. Our topics addition and subtraction, measurement and time. We will also have a focus on mental maths, with a daily test to start each lesson. As well as timestables in preparation for the year 4's MTC at the end of the year.

## Art

In our art lessons we will be developing a variety of different skills and techniques to create pieces using a pointillism style. We will be using pointillism techniques to blend colours and create artwork linking to other subject topics throughout the term.

## Science

Science is timetabled for Wednesday afternoons. This term our topic is earth and space. We will conduct a range of experiments to explore the planets in our solar system, day and night and the phases of the moon. We will also be linking this back to our previous knowledge of science and the topic of earth and space from previous years.

## Computing

























Our two main focuses this term for computing are word processing and presentation. We will practice these skills through a range of topics linked in with other lesson in the curriculum.
