The children have had a great start back to school after the Christmas break. They have shown a keen interest in castles, knights, princesses and dragons. A change to our PE routine

As you know, Explorers class currently get dressed for PE within school on a Monday and Wednesday. The reason for this was to help them develop independence when dressing and taking responsibility for organising their belongings within school.

These skills are really important as they feed into daily activities such as putting their own coats on at break time, taking off / putting on jumpers, finding their book bags, reading folders etc. We encourage these skills to be practiced at home too, as it makes time in school and the transition to year 1 a lot smoother.

As the year progresses the children have all come on a great deal with these skills and this is not to say we will stop practicing these skills with coats etc... However with PE kit we feel now they could now come to school dressed in their kit on Mondays and Wednesdays like the rest of the school do.
