


DISCOVERERS Spring Term

English

In English we will be looking at Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura and Arthur and the Golden Rope by Joe Todd-Stanton. We will be writing a narrative piece about the cave in Stone Age Boy also looking at diary writing and instruction writing through the learning journey.



History

Our history topic for this term is the Stone Age. We will spend time focusing on where the stone age falls on a timeline in comparison to other history topics we have looked at as well as covering the Stone Age through workshops and other cross curricular links.

Maths

In maths, we will be building on skills learnt previously this year. Our first topics this term are fractions and geometry and place value, addition and subtraction. We will also have a focus on mental maths, with a daily test to start each lesson. As well as additional timestables lessons mainly for year 4s.

Art

Our Art will link to the Stone Age (our history topic). We will be having weekly workshops provided by Wavelength Arts.



Science

Science is timetabled for Tuesday afternoons. This term our topics are animals including humans and magnets. We will also be linking this back to our knowledge of science in previous years.



Computing

Computing will be covered through all subjects. Year 3 will have more specific computing lessons while Year 4 are swimming.

Swimming

Myself, Mrs Ashdown and Mrs Royal will be taking Year 4 and 5 to the Heights on Monday afternoons for a 10 week block of swimming lessons. During the time out of the pool, children will be completing French work linked to their French lessons and timetable work in preparation for MTCs
