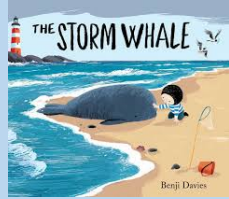


Adventurers Autumn Term

English

In English we will be looking at a variety of books based around underwater creatures. In the first half of the term our writing will be based on whales. We will read the books; snail and the whale, the storm whale and the big blue whale.



Geography

Our Geography learning this term starts by looking at the continents, oceans and learning how to use maps, atlases and globes. We will then begin to look at different climate zones and link our work to our Science topic.

Maths

In maths we will be starting with place value to make sure children have a secure knowledge of number before moving on to addition and subtraction. Then moving onto measurement, specifically money and length. Before finishing the term with multiplication and division.

Science

Science for this half term is on Tuesday afternoons. It follows on nicely from some of our Geography work. We will be looking into seasonal changes and climates around the world. Then narrowing it down to coral reefs and the ecosystems that live there.

Art

Our Art will focus on crafting. We will be making lots of under the sea artwork through different media. Starting with paper plate coral reefs to try out different shapes, colour palettes and proportions. We will then put all our knowledge together and create a large class coral reef painting.

This term we will be recapping previously learned sounds and finding strategies to help us apply our knowledge into our spellings.
