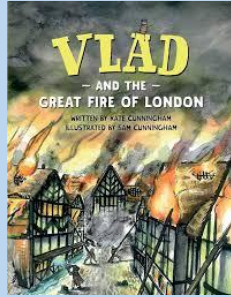


### English

In English we will be looking at a variety of books based around the Great Fire of London.

In the first half of the term we will write recounts, narrative writing and non-fiction information texts. We will read the books; Vlad and the great fire of London, The Baker's Boy and The Great Fire of London by Nick Hunter.



### History

Our History learning this term will be based on National Treasures, people who are historical figures in Britain such as Emily Davison, L.S Lowry, William Caxton and many more. We will also be looking at events such as the Great Fire of London. As well as linking to some Geography work by looking at famous landmarks and their location in the UK

### Maths

In maths we will be covering a lot of different topics including place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, shape and measurement (money, time, length, mass and capacity).

### Art

We have lots of exciting art to do this half term. We will be recreating L.S. Lowry's matchstick people, looking at London's scenery for some landscape work, creating royal portraits and making a ferris wheel (London eye) for a DT project.

Science for this half term is on Tuesday afternoons. We will be looking at different materials, their use and suitability and changes over time. This will link nicely with our history work when we look at everyday life and compare it to nowadays.

### RE
